Outline of the report

The conflict in northern districts of Helmand, different district of Nimroz and Bakwa district of Farah province the displacement continued till middle of November 2014. A number of civilians fled their places of origin, majority moved to Zaranj City of Nimroz province. Some families reported arrived and settled with their friends/relatives while some families settled in destroyed governmental buildings rental houses.

Also the natural disasters such as drought, lack of potable water, joblessness, stingy Wind during the different seasons of present your affected people including children, women and old men/disables

So Nimroz ANDMA requesting winterization items particularly warm clothes for mentioned affected population by natural disasters/conflict during this year. Therefore, OCHA intended to convene a meeting for further planning or responding to the needs of vulnerable people. The meeting took place on Tuesday 25 November 2014. In the mentioned meeting all the participants decided that a joint assessment team will be organized in order to verify the mentioned children and people which affected in the previous natural disasters during this year in Nimroz Province

So the joint assessment conducted by from WHO, WFP, ANDMA Nimroz, DoRR Nimroz and HAPA Representatives 30/11/2014 till 03/12/2014

So the Findings derived from interviews conducted through home visits with 300 families in different locations of Zaranj City of Nimroz province

So the Living conditions of mentioned 300 families some of the mentioned families lived with relatives/friends as well as tribesmen while some families rented houses which they are not able to pay the rent of rented houses. Few families found lived in destroyed buildings

As per the team findings and Beside of the above recommendation, it is recommended the following is recommended for improvement of the conditions of the mentioned families

- Non-food items assistance specially their children for winterization items
- Needed Food Items
- Around 50 families they need for shelter

- potable drinking water
- Providing Job opportunities like vocational training /Income generating activities to be considered for youths, adult male and females.
- Child protection program and providing child friendly place
- Agencies/NGOs to include IDPs in their food for work (FFW) and/or cash for work (CFW) projects if any.

Statistical overview

The total displaced populations are 2063 persons {(male 917 (47%) and female 1146 (56%) including children from 0 to 5 years of age 29% and children from 6 to 12 years 71%)

Report of submitted

After analyzing the report by joint assessment team the Narrative report submitted to UNICEF, UNOCHA, and other donors so UNICEF provided the NIFs (Winterization and hygiene kit) for verified 300 families, according to the rule and regulation HAPA distributed from 23/12/2014 and completed one 27/12/2014 in Zaranj City of Nimroz Province
